ABOUT THE SETTING

Our purpose built playroom and secure spacious garden combines the environment of a nursery plus the interaction and care of a childminder.

There is a small kitchen and toilet facilities, a spacious indoor play area and plenty to do outside, either in our small wood area, sandpit, balance beams or stretch there legs in the open space. Then after a hard day playing and exploring there are plenty of places to rest and refuel.

HOURS & RATES

Fee's are charged at £5.00 per hour.

Sessions are fully flexible to meet your requirements, a minimum session is 5 hours.

This is inclusive of:

- Breakfast (08:00 - 08:30am)
- Homemade Nutritious Hot Lunch (noon)
- Freshly Made Sandwiches (16:00)
- Snacks
- Drinks

School Drop-Offs and Collections are charged at hourly rate above.

TRIPS OUT

We will often go on trips out, inclusive of but not limited to:

All trips are booked in advance and parents are always informed, where there is an extra cost this will be discussed prior to the trip.



HOLIDAYS

We all love to go on holiday and often within childcare settings fee's still must be paid when you take holiday.

We are happy to be different and allow up to 2 weeks of holiday to be taken each year as long as 4 weeks notice has been given.

We are closed during the Christmas week, dates are given out closer to the time each year and we may go on holiday for 1 week over the summer, however we will always give a months notice before this.



SICKNESS

Sickness will still be charged, however we are happy to discuss and help in any way we can with any longer term illness's.

In the unlikely event of being sick myself, you will not be charged and I will be able to provide other local childminders to assist with this subject to availability.



PAYMENT

Payments are taken via direct debit on the 1st of each month.

The amount will be the agreed cost discussed in your contract, should you wish to have any extra days within 6 days of your direct debit date, these costs will be carried over
